Village of Edgar is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

WWTP Facility Improvements
20540057

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the Edgar Village Hall located at 224 S. Third Avenue, Edgar WI, until Thursday, December 22, 2022, at 10:00am local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

The project consists of upgrading the existing WWTF from an RBC process to Activated Sludge. Major construction includes converting the RBC tanks into aeration tanks. A pump room to house the pumps to supply wastewater to the aeration basin and return sludge pumps will be constructed adjacent to the aeration basin. A new final clarifier will be constructed. The existing final clarifier will have the walls raised from elevation 1242 to elevation 1251. The septage dumping location will be relocated. The idle anaerobic digester will have aeration diffusers added and it will be used as a temporary aerobic digester while repairs are made to the current aerobic digester. The control building will have minor modifications. The existing plant will remain in service during construction.
